Please fill the form using MS Office 2007 or above and save the file as a word file (*.docx) as first author name and abstract no. (If more than one abstract is being submitted by the same author).

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Please email your abstract as per the following guidelines to :-

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ABSTRACTS CAN BE SUBMITTED ONLY BY email.

Abstracts must be submitted by email only as an MS Word file as an attachment. To avoid a situation that your abstract can not be submitted due to technical difficulties, computer problems or other reasons, you are advised to submit your abstract well on time. Please note that abstract submission in the form of a **hard copy will not be accepted**.

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Submission time limit : Last date for abstract submission is **31 st july 2026**.

Submission rules:

1. The presenting author must be the first author.
2. The presenting author must mandatorily be a member of TAPASU or should send the application form with online paid **membership fee details** of Rs.5000/- to **info.tapasu@gmail.com**
3. In case the presenting author is not a member of TAPASU and he/she has sent the abstract form, the submission shall be rejected.
4. Presenting author should be a registered delegate of the conference, one of the author/co-authors should be Member of TAPASU.
5. All papers will be reviewed by a panel of referees before being accepted. Acceptance/rejection of abstract will be intimated by email.
6. Members who fail to present paper after accepting will be debarred from presentation for the next one year. Papers should not be repeated in different formats like Podium/Poster /Video.
7. No delegate can present more than two papers in same category (although delegate can present multiple paper/posters in different categories) and with not more than three presentations (including Papers/Posters/Video/innovations).
8. Submission of abstract implies that the authors agree to the above mentioned rules.
9. Papers and posters should be related to Urology and its sub speciality
10. The scientific committee reserves the right to accept, reject or assign final presentation type.
11. The judges reserve the right to disallow the presentation of the award paper if any technical lapse in the concerned paper is brought to their notice at any time before the presentation.
12. The abstracts will be anonymously reviewed and the outcome of the abstract selection will be notified by email.

Rules for abstract preparation:

Authors: Type full last name and first name of all authors, omitting any titles, degrees and institutional affiliations.

Affiliation:Type the name of the Institution, Department and City.

Title:Type the title in this section.

Size:The size of the abstract is limited to **300 words** and a preferred front is Times New Roman (this includes title, body of abstract, spaces, tables and graphics but excludes authors name and affiliation).

Body of the abstract should have the following headings for research papers:

-Introduction & objectives



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- Materials & methods
- Results
- Conclusions

For case reports the following headings should be used:

- Introduction
- Case report
- Discussion
