About Coutrallam

Coutrallam, the "Spa of the South", is situated at an elevation of about 167 meters on the Western Ghats in Tirunelveli District. It is an excellent health resort. The water of Coutrallam is believed to have medicinal qualities as it flows through forests of herbs.

Coutrallam is 60kms from Tirunelveli and 5kms from Tenkasi. Of the nine water falls, the only one in the village itself is the 60m high main falls. Its sheer rock face is carved with old Hindu insignia that is visible only during the dry months of April and May. Other falls, mostly accessed by shuttle buses, are at a distance of 8kms.

Main Falls: It is in Coutrallam town itself. It is very adjacent to bus stand.

Tiger Falls: It is at a distance of 2kms away from the bus stand.


Chitharuvi (Little Falls): It is situated near the main falls.

Five Falls: It is 4kms away from Coutrallam.

Old Coutrallam: This falls is at a distance of 6kms from Coutrallam.

Shenbagadevi: It cannot be reached by vehicles. You must be prepared to walk in the forest for nearly 2 hours up in the hills.

Then Aruvi (Honey Falls): As Shenbagadevi it is also not reachable by vehicles. It takes an hour journey from the Shenbagadevi in the hills.


